Fall 2006 Rebate Programs Are Underway

Heating and Air Conditioning Section Rebate Program Helps Boost Sales for Members!

The fall 2006 rebate program for heating and air conditioning has begun. 71 contractors are participating in this fall's rebate program. The program runs from September through December, and offers customers rebates of up to \$800 for installing energy efficient central air conditioning or heat pumps. The rebate amounts vary depending upon the energy efficiency of the unit installed, and are only valid for new or replacement units. New construction is not eligible.



Changes to the Gas Conversion Program

PECO Energy has made several changes to the Natural Gas Conversion Rebate Program, or the GAMS Program. These changes were initiated to help participating contractors increase program sales. Changes to the program include increasing the available rebate, and instituting mandatory response times to customer inquiries and leads.

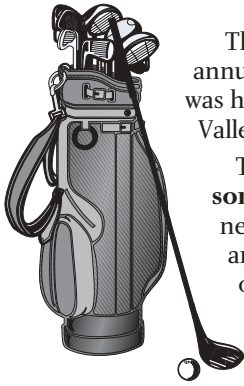

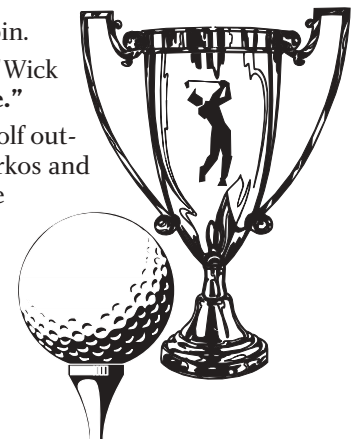
