## Changes to the 2017 NEC & NJ Law

**8 Hour Course – Fri., December 1, 2017**

**2 Hours for New Jersey only – Sat., December 2**

Who needs to know them? Only every person involved in design, sales, installation and inspection of electric wiring and systems does. This is a mandatory 10-hour program for NJ licensed electrical contractors and is required for this renewal cycle. This presentation will focus on the most significant changes to the 2017 National Electrical Code (NEC). The program will be taught over a two-day period, with the final 2 hours being devoted to the contractors' law of the State of New Jersey. By using the 2017 Analysis of Changes Power-Point Program from the International Association of Electrical Inspectors, the instructor is able to provide a visual focus for the students as he explains the new or altered NEC language and its significance.

All NJ licensees must attend the full 10 hour instructional update. Fines penalties and/or loss of license can and have been assessed against violators.
