College or Vo-Tech 4 awards - \$3,000 each

The Educational Foundation of The Electrical Association of Philadelphia is awarding FOUR \$3,000 to current high school seniors planning to enroll in a full-time accredited college, university, or vocational/technical school for the Fall 2018 semester (at least 12 credits per semester). This is an opportunity offered to employees (and their families) from companies who hold membership in the Electrical Association of Philadelphia!

Applications are read and judged by a non-biased, third-party scholarship program management company.

Criteria: (all must apply):

- Be a high school senior planning on attending your freshman year of college or vocational/technical school beginning in the summer of 2018 (at least 12 credits per semester).
- Be a dependent son or daughter of a full-time employee of an EAP member company.
- The parent/guardian must have been employed for at least one year as of January 1 of the year in which the scholarships are awarded.
- The parent/guardian must be employed at the time awards are announced.
- The scholarships will be awarded based upon the applicant's academic performance, extracurricular activities, volunteer/community activities and work experience.

Applications will be made available online beginning January 2, 2018. All applications must be completed (postmarked if mailing) by **March 29, 2018**.
